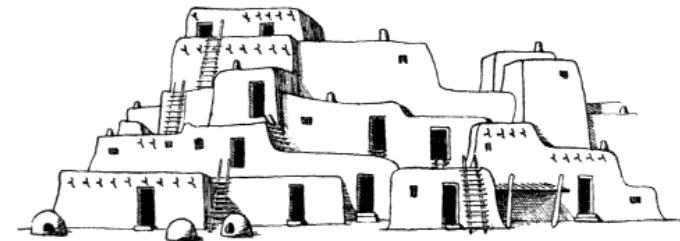

#### Option 1 – Bandelier National Monument

Travel to Bandelier National Monument where you'll descend into a canyon filled with the ruins of the Anasazi Indians, colloquially "the Ancient Ones."
